In terms of student hostel-type accommodation, there is currently availability for Courtbrack Accommodation on Friday and Saturday May 19th and May 20th.

This is a student accommodation complex owned and managed by Mary Immaculate College Limerick, situated on Shannon/ Galway side of Limerick on the Dock Road. Courtbrack offers safe and secure accommodation for students from September to May each year and then offers safe and secure budget accommodation during the summer months.


