Please bring details to attention of members in your area.

1/. **MOTIONS:** Copies of the final list of Motions are attached. If your branch has photocopying difficulties additional copies may be obtained from Head Office. Every delegate will receive a copy of motions on registration.

2/. AMENDMENTS: Amendments to motions should be submitted by Friday May 3rd for written circulation at ADC registration. Amendments may be tabled subsequently, including at ADC, subject to Steering Committee acceptance. The amending branch should firstly seek agreement with the proposing branch in consultation with Steering Committee. Please use the amendment procedure sparingly.

3/. ATTENDANCE: Each constituency / branch will be contacted by phone concerning delegate entitlement. All members have been sent a preliminary Confernce Guide and all will receive a Members' Card in advance of Conference. Delegate Cards will be issued, either to branches by agreement in advance of the ADC, or to individual delegates at ADC Registration.

In addition to head office mailings, please ensure that direct contact is made by your branch with all members and supporters in your area inviting them to attend.

4/. **VISITORS:** Visitors Cards are included with this mailing. They should be circulated to individual organisations and individuals in your area. Additional Visitors Cards are available from Head Office on request. People interested in Unemployment issues should be particularly encouraged to attend the debate on this issue on Saturday morning.
