The film is filled with stock characters—such as the Jewish shopkeeper, the Irish cop, the suffering Jewish mother—played with great comic flair by a remarkable cast in their prime. The film has been jointly restored by the Cinémathèque Royale de Belgique and the IFR Irish Film Archive.
