

At the first quorum meeting of The D.I.T. Student Council subjects from motions for U.S.I. congress to a briefing on D.I.T.S.U.'s Policy on free fees were discussed.

Colman Byrne president D.I.T.S.U. briefed the meeting on the work that the S.U. had been involved in during the year. Also Colman informed the meeting on the recent stunt performed by D.I.T.S.U. Sabbaticals at Dail Eireann on the 24th of February. The meeting agreed on a policy on The Free Fees issue, the policy demands higher grants, raising of threshold levels of assessed parents income and also for an increase to be made on the amount of money available to students under the Government's hardship fund along with an introduction of free fees.

Many students queried the level of communication between the D.I.T.S.U. Exec and the student body and it was agreed that minutes of D.I.T.S.U. Exec meetings should be posted on noticeboards in each college.


Furthermore any person who wishes to find out anything regarding D.I.T.S.U. Council should feel free to contact their local S.U.
